

**Sun City PRIDES
Membership Meeting
December 7, 2019**

Meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by President Molly Soblewski.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Molly began the meeting by acknowledging Pat Richardson, Ken Smith and Mike Will for their years of service as members of our Board of Directors.

MCDOT: Troy Gribler reported that both MCDOT and Flood Control are working to clean the canals of debris and plant growth. Of all the canals and ditches in Sun City, only two come under the jurisdiction of Flood Control; the rest come under the jurisdiction of MDCOT. Mike Will acknowledged Oscar's help in planting the new trees on Alabama, west of 107th.

New members: There is one new member in Phase I, no new members in Phase II, and three new members in Phase III.

Minutes: The minutes of the November Membership meeting were read. Jerry Kavanagh moved to accept the minutes. The motion was seconded by Jay Wood, and the motion carried.

Review of November Board meeting: The Board appointed Leon Loupee as treasurer, but he has since resigned for health reasons. The Board approved \$2,000 for trees, \$750 for name badges and \$6,000 for the upcoming Appreciation Luncheon.

Treasurer's report: Income for the month of November was \$83.61. Expenses were \$8,993. The checking account balance is \$5,561.43. Jay Wood moved to accept the report. Ronn Enzweiler seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Beautification Committee: Planting along Alabama from 107th to 111th has been completed. A plan for thirteen plants at Cameo and Del Webb has been approved. Oscar will add irrigation to that area. Mike has placed sandwich board signs in some of our work areas, designating them as Sun City PRIDES projects. The goal is to heighten community awareness of our projects. The landscaping on the north side of Bell Road, just east of the Sun City line, needs attention. The Poulte sign at the corner of Lindgren and Bell Road is in disrepair. Ken has contacted the local office without results, so he will contact the corporate office. The City of Peoria has committed to removing the orange trees and replacing them with appropriate bushes.

Old Business:

Events Coordinator – Sun City's Arbor Day 2020 event will be at 9:00 a.m. on March 26th. The next SCHOA New Resident Orientation is in January.

Building-Equipment manager – John reminded us to sign in tools when they are returned. Annual Appreciation Luncheon is scheduled for February 13, 2020.
