

**Sun City PRIDES
Membership Meeting
January 4, 2020**

Meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by President Molly Soblewski.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

MCDOT: Oscar reported that the backhoe has been repaired, and they are in the process of cleaning out the drainage ditches. They have resumed spraying. Next week is the tentative date for installation of irrigation at Del Webb and Cameo.

New members: There is one new member in Phase I, three new members in Phase II, and no new members in Phase III.

Minutes: The minutes of the December Membership meeting were read. Jay Wood moved to accept the minutes. The motion was seconded by Mike Cullen, and the motion carried.

Review of December Board meeting: Steve Fribley was appointed Treasurer. The 2020 budget was approved.

Treasurer's report: Income for December was \$2,744.06, expenses were \$742.72, and the checking account balance as of December 31st was \$11,099.45. Total income for 2019 was \$51,472.02, total expenses were \$31,293.62, which was a gain of \$20,178.40. Jay Wood moved to accept the report. Jerry Kavanagh seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Beautification Committee: Tree work continues, and Mike said that he can always use more volunteers. Planting along Del Webb and Cameo will begin once the irrigation is in place. There are plans for plants and flowers to be placed in front of the concrete entrance signs to Sun City. Pink dwarf oleanders are to be planted along Bell Road, from 105th to 107th.

Community Education Committee – Deborah Douglas spoke about the power point program which she created for presentation within Sun City.
