

**Sun City PRIDES
Membership Meeting
March 5, 2022**

Meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by President John Terko.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Minutes: The minutes of the February Membership meeting were read. The minutes were amended to reflect that APS is repainting all the street lights throughout Sun City. Ken Smith moved to accept the minutes as amended. James Jerauld seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: \$10,000 was transferred from the Morgan-Stanley account to the checking account. The checking account balance as of 02/28/2022 is \$17,208.

Phase Updates: Phase 1 has four new members and will have a new Phase Coordinator (Carol Beth Hunter) beginning in April. Phase 2 has two new members, and Phase 3 has seven new members. Welcome!!

Articles of Incorporation/Bylaws Review: Molly reviewed the revisions proposed for the two documents. A copy is attached. Mike Will made a motion to accept the revisions for the Articles of Incorporation. Mike Cullen seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously. The Board will vote on the Bylaws revisions at their meeting this morning.

Service Pins: 2019 and 2020 service pins will be available after this meeting. Any not claimed at that time will be delivered by the Phase Coordinators.

County Update: The County has ordered gravel to replace what was washed away along Del Webb by recent storms. The orange bags currently in use are plastic; the County has agreed to look for other material that would be more eco-friendly. The County has approached BlueStake to determine who is responsible for the utility boxes along 99th Avenue, some of which need attention. The County is currently spraying weeds.

Arbor Day: 17 flowering trees will be planted along 108th Avenue on March 10th, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The County will install the irrigation and dig the holes.

Roads & Safety: The February meeting was cancelled. Cindy Hintze reminded us about the crime report session scheduled on March 28th at Sundial.

Signs Update: Lloyd Maple reported that he has received over \$4,000 in donations to pay for the sign project.
