**Minutes:** The minutes of the April Membership meeting were read. Lloyd Maple moved to accept the minutes. Faye Knowles seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** Total income was \$2,545.35; total expenses were \$8,564.55. Checking account balance as of May 7th is \$10,003.41. Morgan-Stanley balance as of March 31, 2022 was \$653,863.25. Cindy Hintze moved to accept the report. Mike Will seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**Phase Updates:** Phase 1- Carol Beth Hunter has moved into her role as the new Phase 1 Coordinator. Phase 2 Coordinator Cheri Marchio introduced a new member. Phase 3 Coordinator Val Bedoe was excused.

**County Update:** The water installation for the area at Peoria and 107<sup>th</sup> has been completed and the agaves planted. Such an improvement!!

**Roads & Safety:** The committee met on April 20<sup>th</sup>. Cindy reported that the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office will conduct a 1-year study on the Flock cameras that have been recently been trialed in Youngtown. SCHOA is hopeful that Sun City will be included in the study. MCSO suggests that residents put locks on their electrical boxes to prevent vandalism. MCSO and Community Bridges are working together to assist the homeless in the county with their "Hand in Hand" program.
