

**Sun City PRIDES  
Membership Meeting  
October 1,2022**

Meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by President John Terko.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

**Minutes:** The minutes of the May Membership meeting were read. Molly Soblewski moved to accept the minutes. Ron Bedoe seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** Total income since May 7, 2022 was \$2,186.56; total expenses were \$6,795.54. Checking account balance as of October 1st is \$5,394.43. Morgan-Stanley balance as of August 31, 2022 was \$588,577.25. Cindy Hintze moved to accept the report. Stan Pastorek seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**Phase Updates:** Phase 1- Carol Beth Hunter was excused. Phase 2 Coordinator Cheri Marchio thanked all who worked through the summer and reminded folks to report their hours for September. Phase 3 Coordinator Val Bedoe thanked her folks as well.

**County Update:** Val reported that the County removed the patio in PRIDES' Park and put in new rock and irrigation, all at no cost to us. They will trim the palms in the near future. The medians across from the Sun Bowl have new earth, the cacti have been removed, the irrigation system has been replaced and new stone has been put in. Some of the orange trees along Thunderbird (from 107<sup>th</sup> heading east) have been removed and will be replaced with new trees. The south sidewalk along Bell Road/ Del Webb seems always to be full of sand. The County has cleared the sidewalk and will apply a coating of "gorilla snot" to keep the sand in place. The owners of the AutoNation sign on Bell Road near Surprise have agreed to clean up that area, as will the owners of the Sun City Anthem sign at the corner of Bell and Lindgren. Flood Control took down some 16 dead trees in the canal behind Safeway. The County took down the dead trees in Bench Park at 103 and Olive.

**Signs Update:** Lloyd announced that the signs are completed! Irrigation has been placed in front of the monument signs, and plans are underway for planting flowers. Lloyd added that plants along Del Webb are dead or dying. Val will check ask the County to evaluate the irrigation system along there.
