

Minutes of the Sun City Prides October 2, 2021, General Membership Meeting

Ronn Enzweiler opened the meeting at 9:00 am.

Secretary Report: No Secretary report was read as Melinda Wills was absent.

Treasurer Report: Bob Geier reported as expenses \$9,784.00 with a checking account of \$3,607.00. See attached report. Mention was made of Prides' receipt of \$1100.00 from the Posse Shred-a-thon minus \$400.00 for Prides' sponsorship of this event. Motion was made at a previous meeting to use this money for the beautification of Prides' Park.

Memorial Tree Signage: Ronn Enzweiler reported that all signs painted orange for the members being remembered at the 2021 Arbor Day have been placed at those specific trees on 109th and Peoria.

Elm Trees care needs Chair: Several of these trees have died with no explanation. Ronn Enzweiler has contacted Maricopa County Plant Hotline to obtain expert advice in caring of the Sun City trees. See attached email.

Sign Committee: Lloyd Maple reported on the status of this Committee. Lloyd Maple will meet with the Committee as well as the bodies involved in furthering the mission of this Committee. Pulte owns signs at Beardsley and 99th, Alabama and 99th, Peoria and 11th. Rotary Club donation has been approved by Rotary, however, as yet has not been received. Ken Schueman will follow up with obtaining this donation. Lloyd Maple will arrange a future meeting for the Prides Sign Committee.

Board Election: A Nominating Committee will be meet at the end of October, 2021, to include the 3 Phase Coordinators and Member, Sue Klawitter.

Work Plan: The Yearly County Agreement with the Prides has been signed by Ronn Enzweiler, President. County will continue to provide to the Prides, gloves, orange bags and vests.

Ditch: Flood Control to be contacted by the County re: the cleaning of the canal at 99th and Hutton.

Irrigation-timer/supplies: Prides has been asked by the County to NOT participate in the maintenance of the irrigation system throughout Sun City. Prides should contact (Arturo) through the County Dispatcher phone 602/506-6063 at Roadway Hazard Hotline should the Prides find any irrigation issues. No irrigation supplies will be provided to the Sun City Prides.

Prides Park: County has agreed to trim trees, remove and replace rocks, remove present irrigation system with a new irrigation system taking into consideration the County's plan for new plants. There is a memorial bench at Prides Park that needs to be relocated either in the Prides Park or elsewhere.
